



❧ HOW TO PLAY ROULETTE ❧

Roulette is a game played in nearly every major casino that anyone can learn in just moments after placing your first bet. A small ball is rolled around a spinning numbered wheel. Simply guess which number the ball will land on and bet accordingly. You can make as many or as few bets as you would like during each round, as long as you play at least the table minimum bet.

Playing Field - The roulette playing field is made up of 36 numbered red and black squares and two green 0 and 00 squares. Outside of the numbered squares are additional betting spots including black, red, odd, even, 1-18, 19-36 and six separate row and column bets. Chips can be placed on any of these sections to make a bet.

Betting Round - Between each roll, the dealer will allow players to make bets on the playing field. Soon, the dealer will begin to spin the ball. Once the ball begins to slow down, the dealer will wave his hand over the playing field to signal that no more bets can be made. Once the ball has stopped, the dealer will take note of the number, remove the losing bets and pay the remaining winning bets. At this point, players may take their winnings from the board and a new round of betting begins.

Betting "Outside" - Outside bets are the easiest way to get into roulette quickly. All outside bets pay 1-to-1 or "even money". A bet of 1 chip would result in a win of 1 chip. These bets include: BLACK, RED, ODD, EVEN, 1-18, or 19-36. If the ball lands on a number that corresponds to any of these conditions you win. 0 and 00 are special numbers which are neither odd/even, red/black or 1-18/19-36 and any outside bet will be lost if either number lands on the wheel.

Betting Rows/Columns - Special squares on the field allow you to bet a column of numbers or four rows of numbers at a time. These squares are designated as "1st 12", "2nd 12", "3rd 12" and "2-to-1". If the ball lands in the corresponding rows or column you bet on, you will win 2-to-1, or 2 chips for every 1 you bet.

Betting "Inside" - Inside bets are bets on the actual numbers themselves. If you want to bet on the number 7, you can place your chips directly on the number 7 in hopes that the ball will land on this number. If it does, you will win 35-to-1 or 35 chips for every 1 you bet. There are a number of ways to make inside bets that all payout different odds. Here is a chart showing all of the possible bets:

A) Single # bet: Pays 35-to-1	B) Two # split bet: Pays 17-to-1	C) Three # split bet: Pays 11-to-1
D) Four # split bet: Pays 8-to-1	E) 0, 00, 1, 2, 3 only: Pays 6-to-1	F) Six # split bet: Pays 5-to-1
